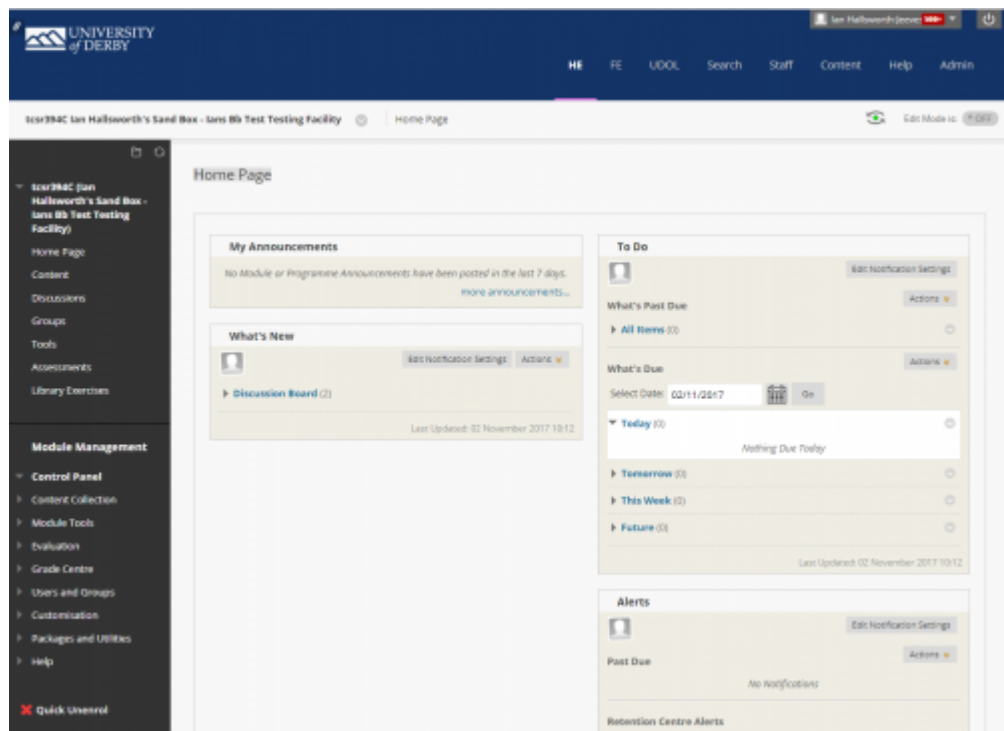


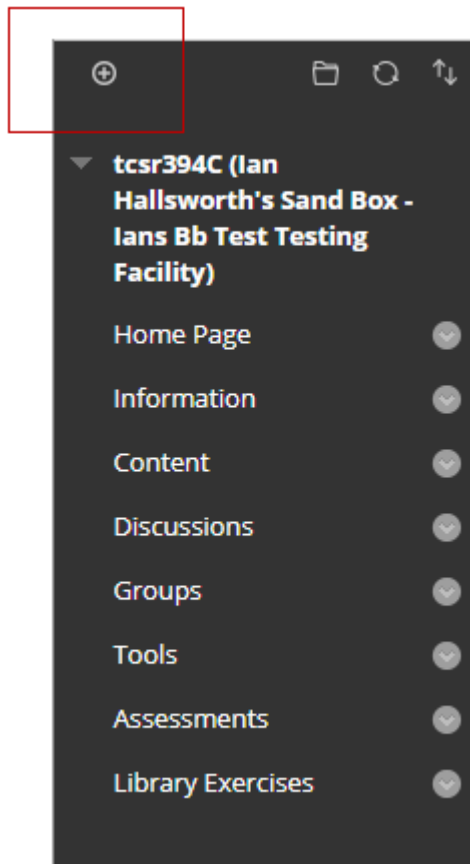
ATLAS - How to add ATLAS to Course Resources

Adding a link to ATLAS from Course resources

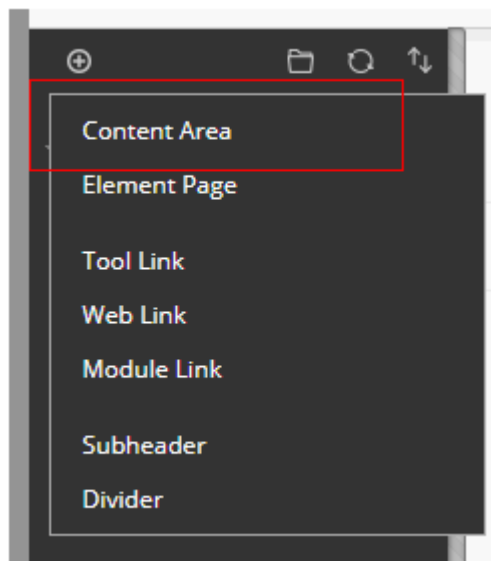
1. Log into Course Resources and the module you want a link to ATLAS from



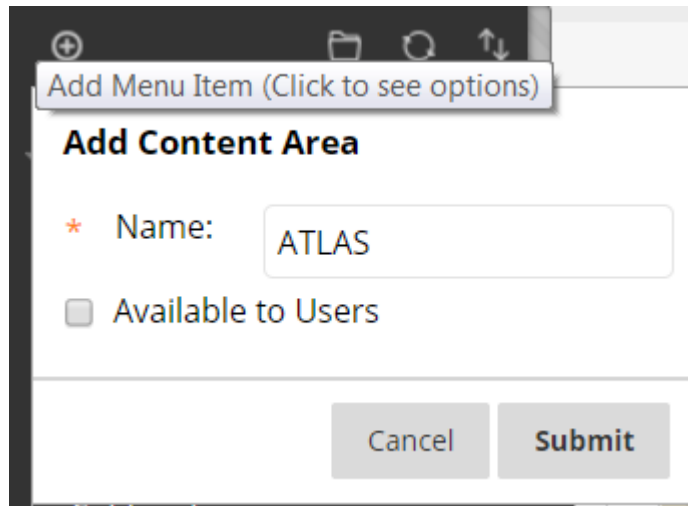
2. Create a new 'content area' by clicking on the small plus sign in the top left hand corner of your menu bar



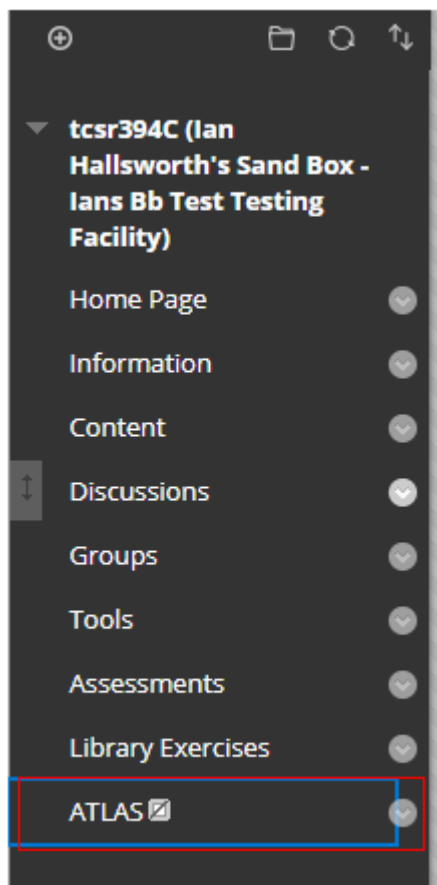
3. Select "Content Area"



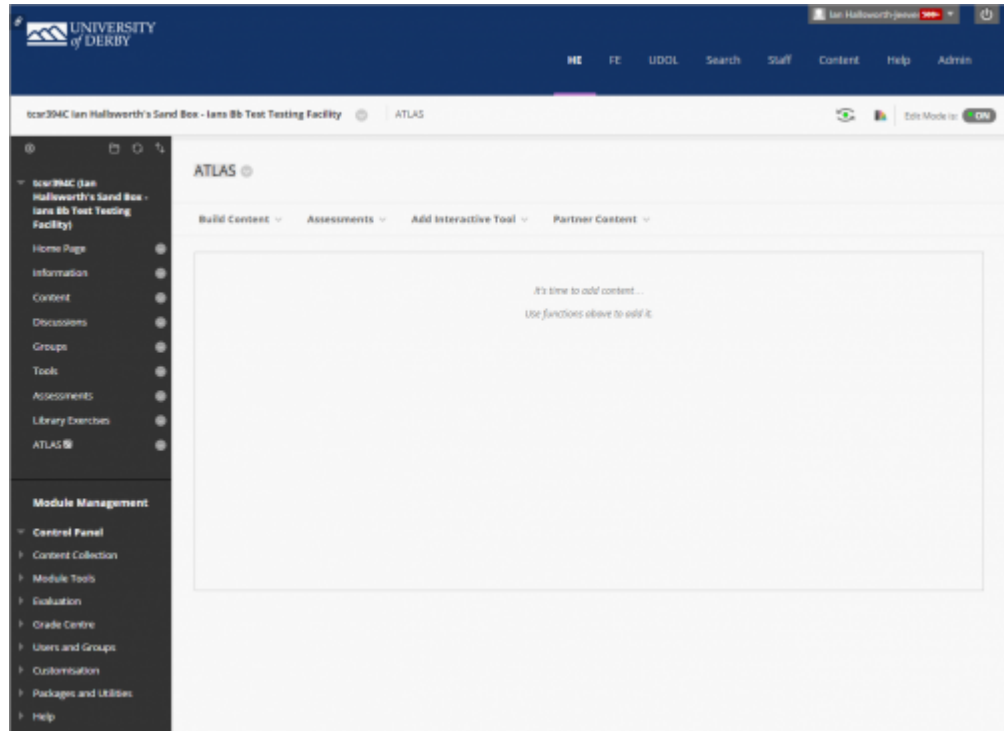
4. Name the content area 'ATLAS' and leave this unavailable to students. Students will not need to access this link. This link is for you to be able to manage submissions and feedback



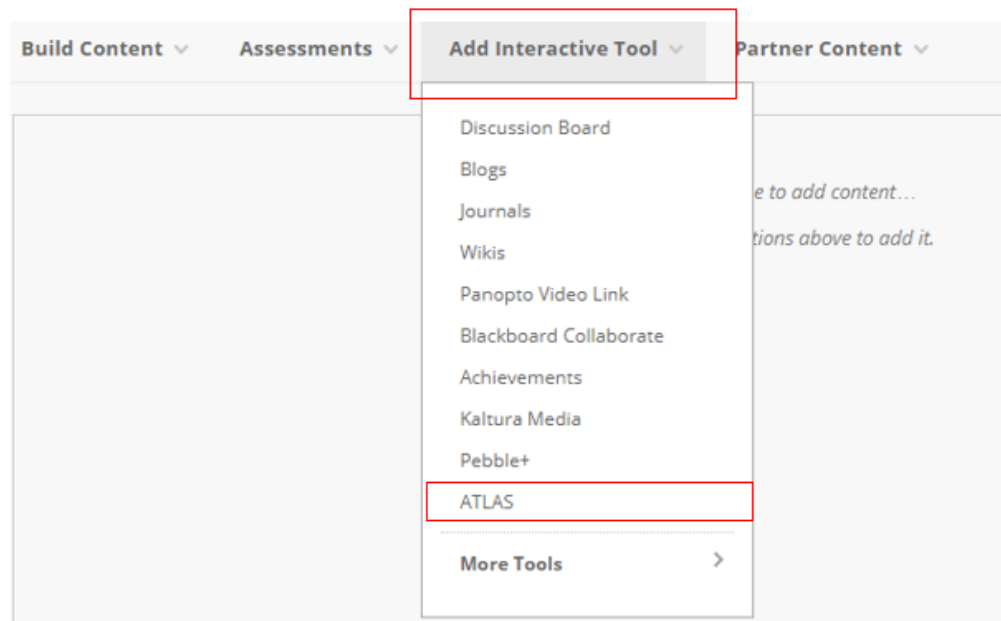
5. Click 'Submit'
6. You'll now see the 'ATLAS' link on the left hand side menu, but hidden from students.



7. Click on the ATLAS content area that you have just created.



8. From 'Add interactive tool' choose 'ATLAS'



9. A form will then appear, you do not need to add or change anything in this form. Just click on 'submit'
