

Advice for students using WeVideo

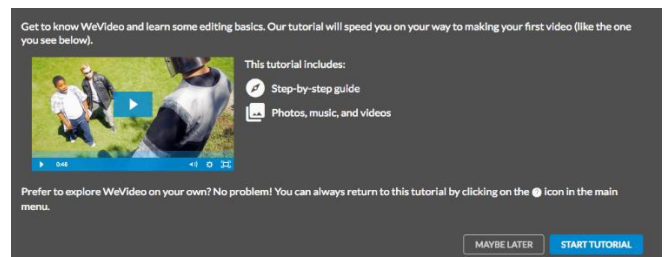
WeVideo is an online editing software that are able to access that makes it easy to capture, edit and share your video. It has a free plan, alongside their paid for plans. The benefit of this being online is that you can edit and view anywhere.

- If you have been given a video assessment on your course, your lecturer will provide you with the sign-up link document to gain full access to all of WeVideo's features.

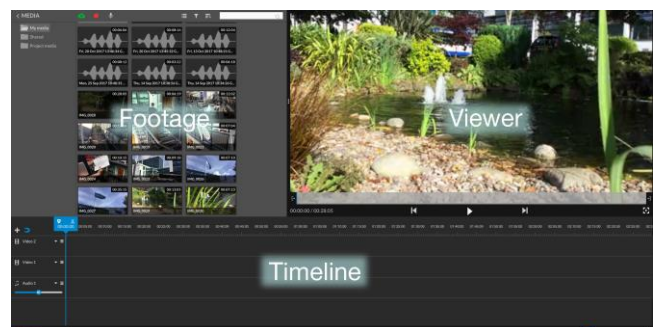
There is some guidance on how to use it on the WeVideo site:

When signed in you can then use WeVideo to import your footage and edit on the timeline to create your video.
